

AIRE-FLO EQUIPMENT LIMITED WARRANTY

APPLIES IN U.S.A. AND CANADA ONLY

FAILURE TO MAINTAIN YOUR EQUIPMENT WILL VOID THIS WARRANTY.

COVERED EQUIPMENT

The following Aire-Flo heating and cooling equipment is covered by the Limited Warranty:

Gas Furnaces: 80AF1DF, 80AF1UH, 92AF1DF, 92AF1UH, 95AF1DF, 95AF1UH, 95AF2DFV, 95AF2UHV, AF80, AF90, AF92, CG80, CG90, CG92, CG95.

Air Conditioners: 2AC13, 4AC13, 13ACD, 2AC14, 4AC14.

Heat Pump - Outdoor Units: 2HP13, 4HP13, 13HPD, 4HP14.

Air Handlers: BCS3, RBC.

Indoor Coils: AC, AH, AU.

FIVE (5) YEAR COVERAGE -- RESIDENTIAL APPLICATIONS

The covered equipment and covered components are warranted by the manufacturer for a period of five (5) years from the *date of the original unit installation*, when installed in a "Residential Application." (A Residential Application is a single-family dwelling which includes homes, duplexes, apartments and condominiums.) If, during this period, a covered component fails because of a manufacturing defect, the manufacturer will provide a free replacement component to the owner through an Aire-Flo dealer or other licensed service contractor. The owner must pay shipping charges and all other costs of warranty service.

ONE (1) YEAR COVERAGE -- NON-RESIDENTIAL APPLICATIONS

Covered equipment and covered components are warranted by the manufacturer for a period of one (1) year from the *date of the original unit installation* when installed in a "Non-Residential Application." (Non-Residential Applications include all properties which were not defined as Residential Applications in the definition above.) If, during this period, a covered component fails because of a manufacturing defect, the manufacturer will provide a free replacement component to the owner through an Aire-Flo dealer or other licensed service contractor. The owner must pay shipping charges and all other costs of warranty service.

EXTENDED COVERAGE

This limited warranty provides extended coverage on the components outlined below. The extended warranty coverage begins with the *date of the original unit installation* and represents the total warranty period for the specific component.

Heat Exchangers:

80AF1DF, 80AF1UH, 92AF1DF, 92AF1UH, 95AF1DF, 95AF1UH, 95AF2DFV, 95AF2UHV, AF80, AF90, AF92, CG80, CG90, CG92, CG95 – Twenty (20) years – Residential Applications.

80AF1DF, 80AF1UH, 92AF1DF, 92AF1UH, 95AF1DF, 95AF1UH, 95AF2DFV, 95AF2UHV, AF80, AF90, AF92, CG80, CG90, CG92, CG95 – Ten (10) years – Non-Residential Applications.

Compressors:

2AC13, 4AC13, 13ACD, 2AC14, 4AC14, 2HP13, 4HP13, 13HPD, 4HP14 – Five (5) years – Non-Residential Applications.

NOTE - If the date of original installation cannot be verified, the warranty period will be deemed to begin six (6) months after the date of manufacture.

COMPONENT AVAILABILITY

In the event that a component covered by this warranty is no longer available, the manufacturer will, at its option, provide a free suitable substitute component or allow the owner to purchase an equivalent new Aire-Flo unit at a reduced price of 20 percent of the manufacturer's list price in effect on the date of the failure. The owner must pay shipping charges and all other costs of warranty service.

EXCLUDED COMPONENTS

The following components are not covered by this warranty: cabinets, cabinet pieces, air filters, driers, refrigerant, refrigerant line sets, fuses and unit accessories.

REPAIRS

All repairs of covered components must be made by a licensed professional HVAC technician, or equivalent, using parts as specified by the manufacturer.

CARE OF EQUIPMENT

This new Aire-Flo unit must be properly installed, operated and maintained by a licensed professional HVAC installer (or equivalent) or service agency in accordance with the unit installation, operation and maintenance instructions provided with each Aire-Flo unit. Failure to provide maintenance per the instructions will void this warranty. The owner may be asked to provide written documentation of annual and other periodic preventive maintenance. This warranty similarly does not apply to, nor is any warranty offered by the manufacturer for, any unit ordered over the internet, by telephone, or other electronic means unless the dealer selling the unit over the internet, by telephone or other electronic means is also the installing contractor for the unit.

WARRANTY PROCEDURE

When warranty parts are required:

- 1 - Be prepared to furnish the following information:
 - a - Complete model and serial number.
 - b - Proof of required periodic maintenance, installation date and location.
 - c - An accurate description of the problem.
- 2 - Call a local Aire-Flo dealer or contractor.
- 3 - If the installing dealer is unable to provide warranty parts, check the yellow pages for another Aire-Flo dealer in the area or call 1-800-982-2333. Refer to the Aire-Flo website at www.aireflo-hvac.com for more information, or contact:

WARRANTY LIMITATIONS

- 1 - The manufacturer will not pay labor involved in diagnostic calls, or in removing, repairing, servicing, or replacing parts. Such costs may be covered by a separate warranty provided by the installing contractor.
- 2 - This warranty is void if the covered equipment is removed from the original installation site.
- 3 - This warranty does not cover units which do not meet and/or are installed in violation of regional government standards or other government requirements.
- 4 - This warranty does not cover aluminum coils installed in applications other than those specified by the manufacturer.
- 5 - This warranty does not cover damage or defect resulting from:
 - a - Flood, wind, fire, lightning, mold, or installation and operation in a corrosive atmosphere, or otherwise in contact with corrosive materials (chlorine, fluorine, salt, recycled waste water, urine, fertilizers, or other damaging substances or chemicals).
 - b - Accident, or neglect or unreasonable use or operation of the equipment, including operation of electrical equipment at voltages other than the range specified on the unit nameplate (includes damages caused by brownouts).
 - c - Modification, change or alteration of the equipment, except as directed in writing by the manufacturer.
 - d - Operation with system components (indoor unit, outdoor unit and refrigerant control devices) which do not match or meet the specifications recommended by the manufacturer.
 - e - Operation of furnace with continuous return air temperature of less than 60°F (or 55°F when furnace is operated **overnight** in setback mode).

- f - Operation of a furnace that is field-installed downstream from a cooling coil.
- g - Operation of a system containing R410A refrigerant without the required filter drier. All systems containing R410A refrigerant must include a filter drier. The filter drier must be replaced when compressor replacement is necessary.
- h - Use of contaminated or alternate refrigerant.

The installation of replacement parts under the terms of this warranty does not extend the original warranty period.

The manufacturer makes no express warranties other than the warranty specified above. All implied warranties, including the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, are excluded to the extent legally permissible. Should such exclusion or limitation of the warranty be unenforceable, such implied warranties are in any event limited to a period of one (1) year. Liability for incidental and consequential damages is excluded. Some states do not allow limitations on the duration of an implied warranty or the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the limitations or exclusions may not apply to the owner.

The manufacturer will not pay electricity or fuel costs, or increases in electricity or fuel costs, for any reason whatsoever, including additional or unusual use of supplemental electric heat. This warranty does not cover lodging expenses.

The manufacturer shall not be liable for any default or delay in performance under this warranty caused by any contingency beyond its control.

This warranty gives the owner specific legal rights, and the owner may also have other rights which vary from state to state.
